Parents Code of Conduct

As adults, we must set examples for all children, most importantly, our own. Clovis Youth Soccer Association expects parents, and fans, to adhere to the Code of Conduct outlined below. When issues arise, the following set of standards will be used by CYSA to determine outcomes:

The Phrase "it's only a game" emphasizes the fun aspects of athletics and seeks to minimize the impact of personal and institutional competitive pressures to win. Everything you say or do makes an impression on kids. What they don't see, they often sense. Be careful to send only worthy messages.

Your praise and criticism is amplified many times in the mind of a child. Praise works best in public; criticism in private.

Good character is to be praised more than outstanding talent. Most talents are a gift. Character is not given to us. We have to build it piece by piece – by thought, choice, courage, and determination.

Just remember the six (6) pillars of character: *trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship*. These values will guide your children the rest of their lives, whether they win or lose a game.

You will be given 1 warning by the referee or a CYSA Board Member, after that, you will be asked to leave the complex or the Clovis Police will be contacted.

Any player, coach, or fan ejected from a Clovis Youth Soccer Association event, or anyone asked to leave a Clovis Youth Soccer Association event due to poor conduct, will be suspended for a minimum of (2) games. If the incident proves to be severe, permanent expulsion from Clovis Youth Soccer Association activities may occur.
